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Conniburrow United Youth Football CLUB RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT (The Hares)

To maximise the enjoyment and safety of all Football Club Members, we have 10 rules that all Youth Club Members are required to abide by. Member that persist in breaking any these rules in part or whole can ultimately have their Membership cancelled. No refunds of fees.

RULES

1. Respect yourself and each other. Treat others as you would wish to be treated.
2. Respect the decisions of your coach/officials
3. Membership is open to any youth in Milton Keynes.
4. No Smoking, Drugs or Alcohol.
5. No Foul Language/Swearing
6. No Fighting.
7. Respect each other and the youth club equipment.
8. No items of value to be brought to club.
9. All members to stay on our premises until the end of the youth club event, unless consent received from parent/guardian.
10. If a member of the team leaves or transfer to another team during the season, there will be no refund and Kit has to be returned to CCA/CUFC.
10. Respect everyone. This is an equal opportunities group. All members to be treated equally irrespective of status, race, gender, or belief.

CODE OF CONDUCT

This club has been established to provide football in a safe and caring environment. The club will strive to achieve this policy to children of both sexes without discrimination due to ability, background or race up to the age of 18.

Players

1. Players signing on for the club must conduct themselves in a polite and friendly manner at all times.
2. Players must respect the facilities provided wherever they are playing or training.
3. At the end of every session/game, a sportsmanlike attitude must be shown (win, lose or draw).
4. Players must respect the decisions of match officials without question.
5. Players must inform their team coach/manager

7. in plenty of time if they are unavailable to play in a game.

Parents

1. Parents are required to pay an annual membership registration and match/training fees as appropriate in advance.
2. Parents are required to transport their child/children to all matches both home and away.
3. Parents may be required to contribute toward the purchase cost of their child's Kit. This remains the property of CCA/CUFC.
4. Any replacement of kit for whatever reason will be paid in full by the parent prior to order.
5. Parents are welcome to encourage all players in a positive manner. Coaching and instructions will be given by the team coaches/managers. The club do not wish to see players receiving instructions from several different sources.
6. Please ensure that your child informs the coach/team manager whenever they are going to be unavailable for a session/game.
7. Please ensure the club contact sheet is completed at the start of every season giving contact details of any medical condition which you may feel appropriate.
8. The club rely on volunteers and fund raising, please help and support in any way you can.
9. Parents are expected to re-imburse the club where their child incurs a fine of administration charge from the F.A or league. For any serious breaches of club discipline, you and/or your child may be suspended or asked to leave or meet with the disciplinary committee of the club.
10. Photographs/videos cannot be taken of any children during matches; this would constitute a breach of league safeguarding rules.
11. No fighting swearing, smoking, is acceptable or permitted on any property used by the Club, home or away.

Coaches/Managers

1. Coaches/Managers are expected to support the club policies on fair play and sportsmanship at all times. Players must be positively encouraged. Coaches/Managers must act with self-control and act as role models to their players.
2. The club does not wish to adopt a "win at any cost" attitude. The primary aim of the club is to provide football in a safe and caring environment without discrimination.
3. Coaches/managers are expected to set an example to their players in all their dealings with players, managers, and spectators of opposing clubs as well as all officials.
4. Coaches/Managers are responsible for the wellbeing of players whilst in their care. No discrimination by other players, parents, etc., is to be tolerated. Coaches/managers are encouraged to raise any concerns with the officials of the club and the child protection officer if appropriate.
5. Players from disadvantaged backgrounds will not be excluded from playing due to lack of means or equipment.
